| Presenting 30 mins | Ask students to vote for the best presentation (individually) by writing the word that group presented on a piece of paper. The teacher can also join by voting. |
| Feedback | 1. Ask 2 students to help you select the best group. |
| 3 mins | Praise the winners and announce the selected word as the word of the day. |
| | Write it on top of the black/white board with a sentence used to introduce the word. |
| Variations | You can note down any common errors in language/ pronunciation to highlight when giving feedback. |
| | You can give new words or ask groups to select their own word on a previous date and assign 1 group each to present a word at the start/ end of each class. |
| | If time permits, get students to mingle and model and drill their word with other students and later write the new words with the sentence used to bring out their meaning. |
