Lesson 1:

Prepositions

What is a preposition?

A preposition is a word used to link nouns, pronouns or phrases to other words within a sentence.

They act to connect the people, objects, time and locations of a sentence.

Prepositions are usually short words, and they are normally placed directly in front of nouns.

Examples of Prepositions

- I prefer to read *in* the library.
- He climbed <u>up</u> the ladder to get <u>onto</u> the roof.
- Please sign your name <u>on</u> the dotted line.
- Go <u>down</u> the stairs and <u>through</u> the door.
- He swam *across* the pool.
- Take your brother *with* you.

Types of Prepositions

1. Prepositions of Time

They are used to tell when something happened, happens or will happen.

For example:

- I was born **on** July 4th, 1982.
- I was born in 1982.
- I was born **at** exactly 2am.
- I was born two minutes **before** my twin brother.
- 2. Prepositions of Place

They are used to tell where something happened, happens or will happen.

For example:

- The cat is **on** the table.
- The dogs are **in** the kennel.
- He stood at the bus stop.
- The cat is **under** the table.
- Put the sandwich **over** there.

3. Prepositions of Movement

They are used to tell how something or someone moves from one place to another. It talks about the direction.

For example:

- I will go **to** bed when I am tired.
- Mike travelled **across** America on his motorcycle.
- James went into the room.
- The horse runs **around** the track all morning.
