






# Lesson-26 Let's construct passive voice sentences. Past simple -passive



- ➤ Generally, we use the passive when the focus is on the action and NOT on WHO or WHAT is performing the action.
  - It was presented in a simple way. (Doer the person who does the action, is not mentioned a completed action in past)
  - A science lesson <u>was taught</u> in an interesting way. (Doer is not mentioned a completed action in past)
  - Curfew <u>was imposed</u> in several areas. ( Doer is not mentioned a completed action in past)
- ➤ If we want to mention the doer we can give it using -by as follows.
  - Dynamite was invented by Alfred Nobel.
  - Light bulb was invented by Thomas Alva Edison.



	Active Voice	Passive Voice
1	The girl took a photograph. (S) (V) (O) 1 2 3	A photograph was taken by the girl. 3 2 1
2	The girls took a photograph. (S) (V) (O)  1 2 3	A photograph was taken by the girls. 3 1
3	The girl took photographs. (S) (V) (O)  1 2 3	Photographs were taken by the girl. 3 2 1

- > The object of the active voice sentence becomes the subject of the passive voice sentence.
- ➤ If the subject of the passive voice sentence is singular the verb is formed by was + past participle
- ➤ If the subject of the passive voice sentence is plural, the verb is formed by were+ past participle
