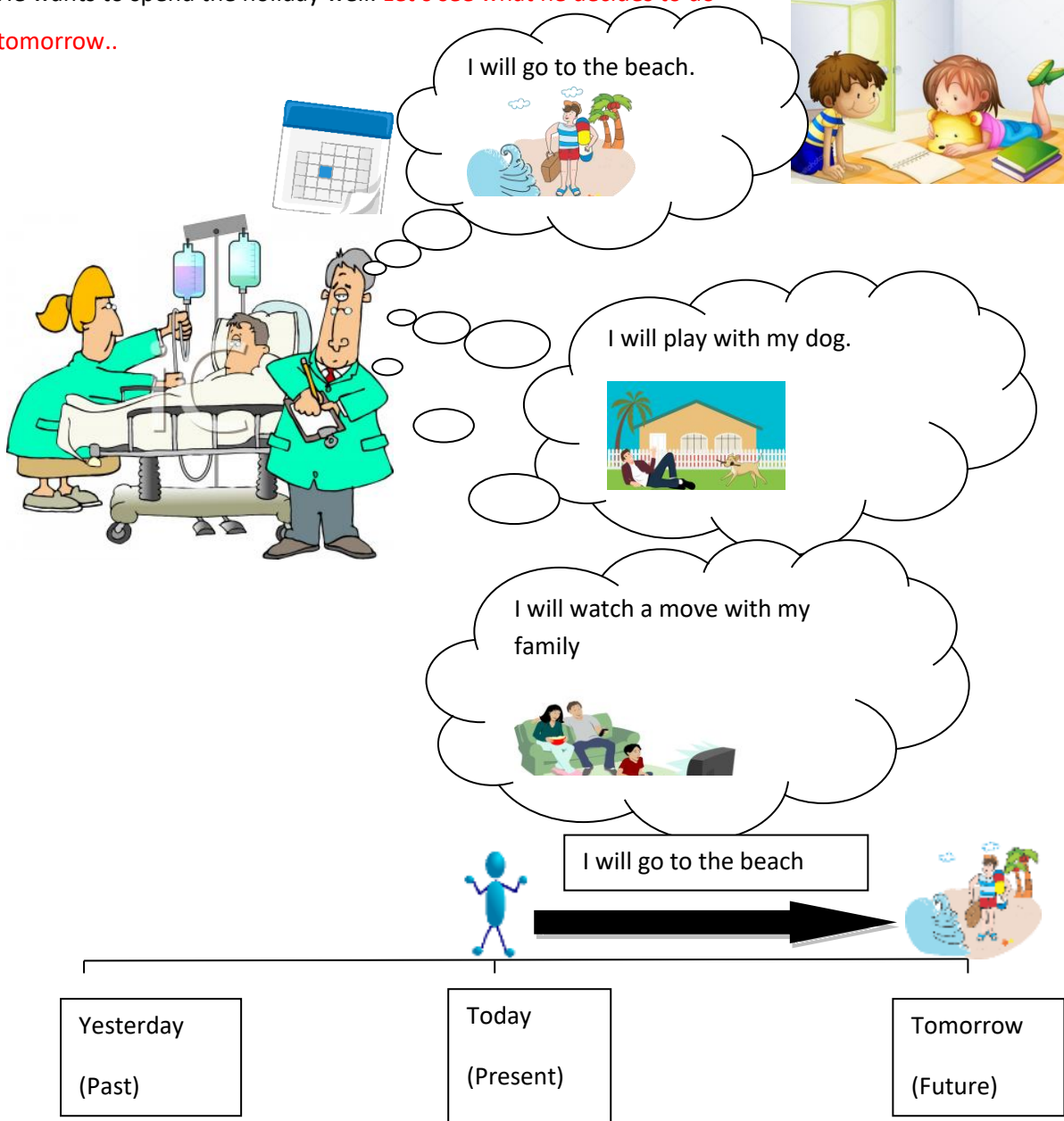


### Lesson-28 Let's learn simple future tense

#### Simple Future Tense

This is Mr. John. He is a doctor. He is busy today. Tomorrow is a holiday.

He wants to spend the holiday well. **Let's see what he decides to do tomorrow..**

**will + basic verb** is common to both the singular and plural subjects. (ඕනෑම ඒක වචන හෝ බහු වචන කතෘ කෙනෙක් සමඟ යෙදිය හැක)

It will drink milk.














Future Tense – Negative form නැත (සානාත්මක අදහස)



Hello teacher,

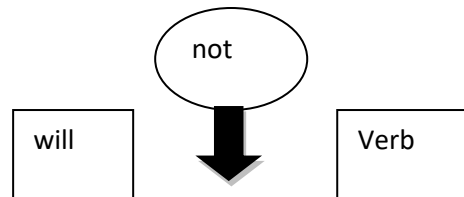
Amali is not well today.

So, she **will not come** to school tomorrow.

She **will not come** to school tomorrow. (අයට පාසල් එන්න බැරි වෙයි )

Look at this verb. The word **not** comes between **will** and **come**.

So we can make negative form using **not**. ( will සහ ක්‍රියා පදයට මැදින් not දැමීමෙන් “නැත” යන අර්ථය සකසා ගත හැක )



The shorten form of “ will not” is “won’t” (කෙටි යෙදුම)





Ex: I will not clean my room.

I won't clean my room.

### Simple future tense - Passive voice

Ex – 1. The children **will play** football in the playground.

Subject      Verb      Object      rest

Football **will be played** in the playground

2. My mother **will cook** rice in the morning.

S      V      O

Rice **Will be cooked** in the morning.

Be verb      past participle

**Will + be + past participle of the main verb**

3. She will not write letters.

Letters **will not be written** by her.
