The present perfect tense is used to talk about an action completed at an unspecified time in the past or in the recent past which have present result.


eg :- I have repaired the car. (So, it works now.)



Teacher - What have they done?




Mother has cooked meals

Have / has + not + past participle

She has brought an umbrella.

She has not brought an umbrella

(hasn't)



They have brought their pens.

They have not brought their pens.
