Logie Baird

Logie Baird was born on August 13, 1888 at Helensburgh near Glasgow in Scotland. He was the youngest of four children, and was often in ill health. He invented the television, and he was the first person in the world to transmit black and white television pictures. Logie Baird made very little money from his great discovery, and died a very poor man in 1946.

Guglielmo Marconi

Marconi was a famous Italian who invented radio. He was born in Bologna, Italy in April 25th, 1874. He studied science at university. He carried out experiments and transmitted messages across the English channel. He developed the wireless and transmitted messages across the Atlantic Ocean from Cornwall in England to St John's, Newfoundland. In 1909, he won the Nobel Prize for his work. He died at the age of 63 in 1937.
