

 We use Present Continuous Tense to describe activity that is happening now.












Present Continuous is formed,



He, She, It - was We, You, They - were

STRUCTURE

Example:

- I am sleeping.
- He is reading a book.
- They are dancing.



PLAY

At the moment *I am playing* tennis.





DRAW

She is drawing a picture at the moment.




- I am studying to become a doctor.
- I am not studying to become a dentist.
- I am reading the book Tom Sawyer.
- I am not reading any books right now.



- You <u>are learning</u> English now.
- You <u>are not swimming</u> now.
- Are you sleeping?
- | am sitting.
- | am not standing.
- Is he sitting or standing?
- They <u>are reading</u> their books.
- They <u>are not watching</u> television.
- What <u>are</u> you <u>doing</u>?
- Why aren't you doing your homework?
