

Capital letters and Punctuation Marks



Capital letters are needed for the *names* of *people* and *places*. *Sentences* always *start* with the capital letters.



Capital letters are used..

❖ To begin Sentences



Ex:-

One day a boy was running along a busy road.

❖ To begin special names

Ex:-

Nipuni and **B**hagya were at the **C**argill's Super **M**arket.




❖ To begin months, dates of the week

Ex:-

Nipuni and Bhagya were at the Cargill's Super Market at on **M**onday, **D**ecember 12th .



❖ Titles



Ex:-

The most famous Sri Lankan book “**M**adol **D**oova” was written by Martin Wickramasinghe.

❖ Exclamation

Ex:-

“**O**h” Cried the beggar.

❖ The pronoun “I”




Ex:-


Kamal and I are waiting at the long queue.



A mark , such as a *full stop*, *comma*, or *question mark*, used in writing to separate sentences and their elements and to clarify meaning.



Full Stop



A “*Full Stop*” is used at the end of a sentence.

Ex:-

He is a good boy.



Question Mark



Use a question mark at the end of all direct questions

Ex:-

What are you doing?
