





Jenner longed to find a way of saving people from this terrible disease and he thought about it a great deal and tried to find out all he could do about it.

After some time he noticed something very interesting. He found that the girls who were employed to milk cows hardly ever caught smallpox, and he began to wonder why many of them caught a disease from the cows called cowpox, which was not serious and from which they recovered quickly. He found that people who had cowpox seemed to be safe from catching smallpox.

One day a girl came to see him who had a cowpox sore on <u>her</u> hand. Jenner took some of the germs of the cowpox from her hand. He then found a little boy of eight called Jimmy Phipps. He made a small scratch on his arm. Into the scratch he put some of the germs of cowpox. Jimmy caught cowpox and soon got better, but later when he came near people who had smallpox he did not catch it, though other people died.

Jenner was very excited at what he had found. He wrote a paper about it and printed it for other doctors to read. That was how vaccination discovered.


