Option 1: Worksheet

Preparation:

- If you have internet access, go to the link above and listen to the story.

Introduction/	 Look at the worksheet and decide if there is any vocabulary that students might need. (i.e. seatbelts, pavement)
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5 mins	 Tell the students that they are going to listen to a story about a dog who keeps people safe. Put up picture of Dino the dog given below. (If printing is a problem draw your own picture and put it up on the board)
Listening 1	 Tell students that they have to listen for the answer to a question.
10 mins	Question: What did dad do while driving?
	 Play the extract. (If you are unable to play the extract, you can read the listening script below.)
	3. Check answer with the whole class
	Answer: He was talking on his mobile phone.
Listening 2	Tell students that they are going to listen to the story again.
+/- 10 mins	2. Give out worksheet 1 (1 per student)
	3. Go to activity 1 of the worksheet. Ask students to listen and write the correct day of the week under the picture (<i>If photocopying is a problem, ask students to draw the pictures in their notebooks and write the day of the week while listening</i>)
Listening 3 10 mins	 Tell students to look at activity 2 and try to remember the answers in groups.
