We should not disclose personal information. We should not readily accept invitations to attend parties during festivals, or else we might fall into cyber traps.

A male student studying at Chinese University of Hong Kong was lured into a gambling fraud in Macau by a lady, he met on the internet. Afterwards, he was said to have accrued 100,000 in gambling debts. He was taken back to Hong Kong and was illegally detained. Among the four accused males involved, three were sentenced to imprisonment at District Court, and another to Detention Centre. The judge pointed out that the criminals had planned well ahead to lure the victim to Macau and target his money.

Further, many internet studies have shown that there is more harm than good for youths to indulge themselves in the cyber world. Without real interaction and communication. It is difficult to develop long-lasting and reliable friendships on the internet. Youths should broaden their social network in daily life such as through joining voluntary work, uniformed units. Sports teams, and so on. Through these ways one makes new and real friends who share common interests.
