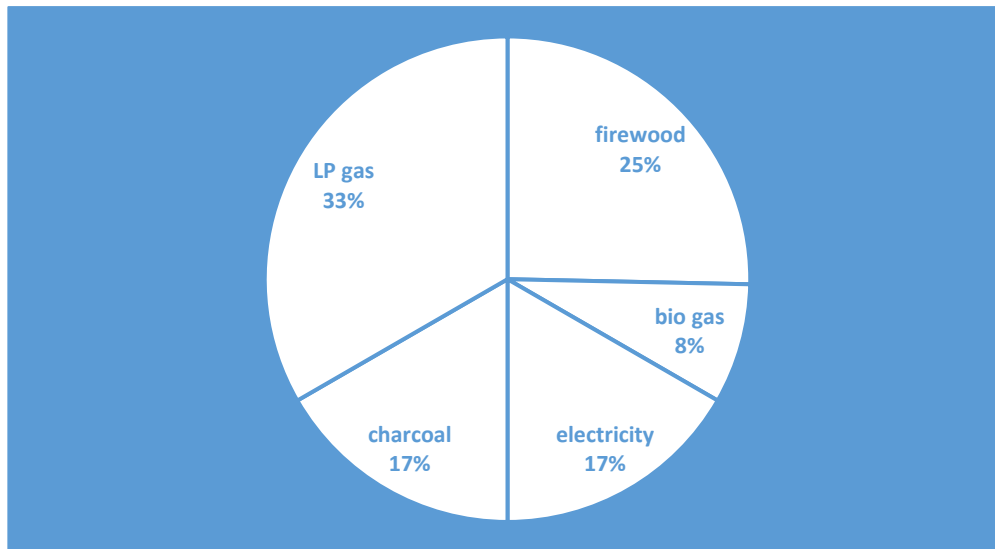

Brenda's husband did not guess the truth for many years. For one thing he insists on handling all domestic correspondence and bills himself. An importer of Persian carpets, he travels a great deal and so was not around much to spot the truth. While he is away, Brenda copes with any situation by explaining that she cannot do anything until she has discussed it with her husband.

Brenda has been very successful in her job. For the last five years she worked as a waitress at an exclusive private club, and was promoted to head waitress. She kept the thing a secret there too, and got over the practical difficulties somehow.
